SOUTHBOUND RIGHT TURN LANE CR 283

QUESTION: Bid item #8 – Is it the intent of the engineer for the contractor to move and relocate the fiber optic box and telephone box or to coordinate with the utility owner for relocation if needed?

ANSWER: *The intent is for the Contractor to provide a cost for that bid item to relocate the fiber optic and telephone box due to the close proximity to the new asphalt sidewalk. The utility company would complete the work for the Contractor.*

QUESTION: Will extra time be allowed for any delays that may be incurred by the fiber optic owners?

ANSWER: *No additional time should be required to relocate the fiber optic box and telephone box. If the Utility Company delays the project, the Contractor would request for additional time to the Owner.*

QUESTION: Bid item #20 – Can an open grade asphalt mix be used for the crack relief layer?

ANSWER: *An open grade asphalt mix, Type S-1 with #78 stone would be acceptable to use in lieu of the crack relief layer.*

CLARIFICATION: Contractors shall substantially complete the Project within 90 calendar days, final completion of project shall be accomplished within 30 calendar days.

Engineers estimate is approximately \$318,000.00

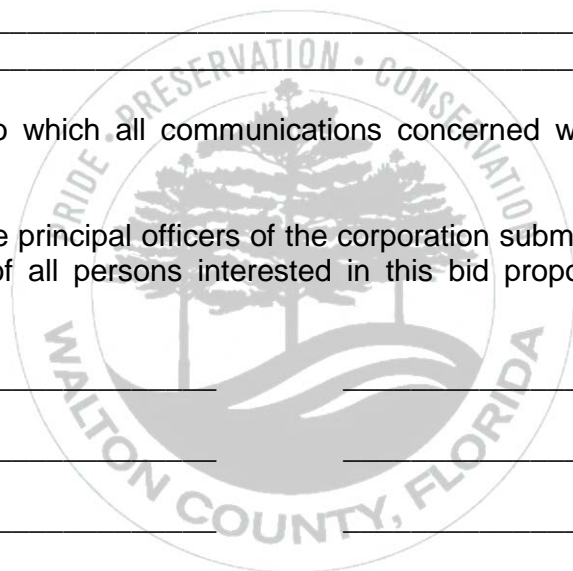

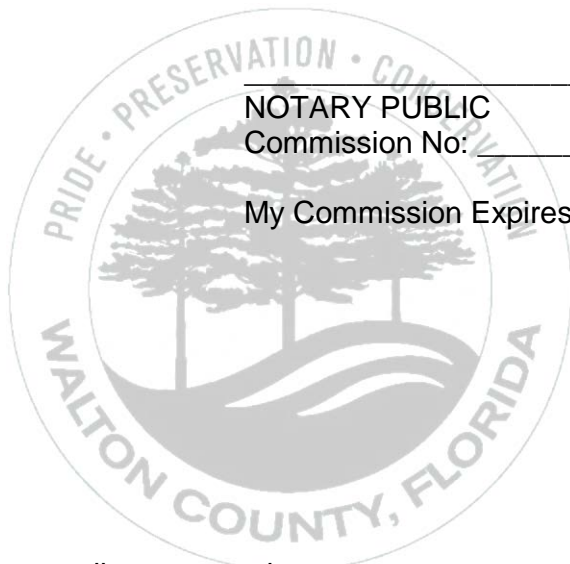

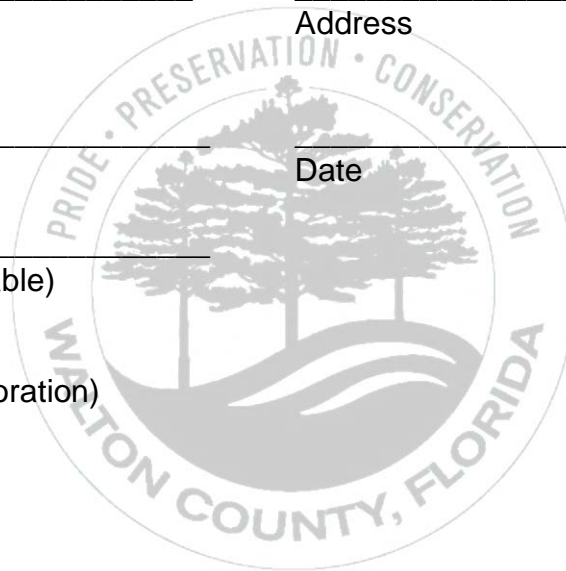
