## How to Make A Yellow Fly Trap

### Supplies:

20 inch beach ball (an empty milk jug will work just as well)

black spray paint

Tangle-Trap Adhesive Glue (available at hardware stores)

Attach a piece of string (about 24 inches long) to the top of the beach ball. Paint the beach ball with the black spray paint and let it dry. Hang the ball about 4 ft from the ground then apply the Tanglefoot glue to the beach ball.

Yellow flies are attracted to the moving sticky trap, where they land, get stuck in the glue, and die.

Note: Buy the spray can of Tangle-Trap if available for easier application. Will need to re-coat when the trap is no longer sticky.
